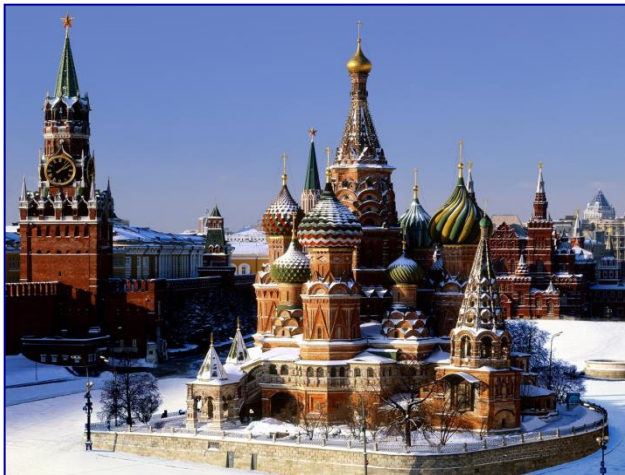




**Russian-British Cultural Centre RUBRIC offers a course on
